We asked the parents 11 questions to gain their view of how well the school performs against safeguarding, teaching and learning. The results obtained will help us improve and further develop the school as we strive to provide the best education for pupils and a fulfilling workplace for adults.

50 parents and carers completed the questionnaire, representing 48% of the pupils in the school.

Conclusion:

- Anti-Bullying is important to the school. I am confident that the school teaches my child an understanding of what bullying is and how to report it.
- This data represents only 48% of the school population, which may or may not fully inform the views of the majority.
- The majority of parents/carers who undertook the survey agree that the school is well led and managed. However, there were a few comments on the rate of change that had been implemented, and as such it was harder to give an opinion.
- The vast majority of parents/carers would recommend the school to another parent, which is a testament to school.
- The pastoral care continues to be a strength; parents confirm that their children are happy and safe in school.

Recommendation:

- Teaching and Learning and pupil progress have scored lower (76%) comparatively and this will be the whole school target next term and beyond.
- We will repeat the survey at the end of summer term to measure progress and inform further school development.
