WHAT ARE THE GATSBY BENCHMARKS?

- A Government backed initiative
- Work is based on research undertaken by the Gatsby Foundation
- Currently more than 3000 schools signed up across England
- Encompasses all 8 benchmarks which are considered to be the "gold standard" for careers provision in schools from worldwide research conducted and created by Sir John Holman
- The aim of the strategy is to ensure that all young people get an excellent programme of advice and guidance, based upon their own needs.

COLLEGE

100% of Year 11 have applied for their college places at either Oaklands or West Herts.

CV is applying for a mainstream Level 1 course in Carpentry at Oaklands.

All Year 11's have experienced both college provisions and will go 1 day a week in Spring to their chosen college to aid a smooth transition.

Taster days and link days have been combined with St. Lukes children to enable them to meet their future peers and enable a smoother transition.

Oaklands now offer a 5 day provision so unfortunately there is not a need for a post-16 provision at St. Lukes.

West Herts and Collett post-16 is alive and well and thanks to Jonathon for all the hard work he has put into this.

We are looking at possibly 5 children for next years transition course.

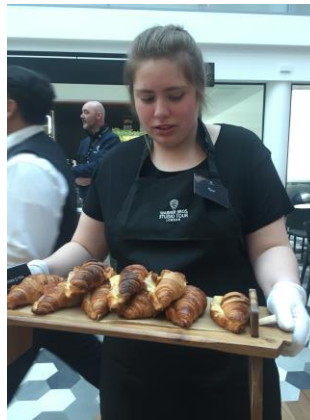
